<b>HCBS Transition Update – Mary Dumas, Northern Michigan Regional Entity (NMRE)</b>	<p>-Erin noted Stuart and Mary were unable to attend &amp; will invite them back at a future date.</p> <p>-Erin noted the Federal Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) transition rule was initiated as a means to better integrate these services helping people with disabilities to live in their own homes and communities. They are currently surveying, and if changes are required providers are being placed on heightened scrutiny. Erin noted currently none of our Providers in the area have received the heightened scrutiny designation.</p> <p>Erin noted outside of the licensed setting, they are also looking at individual Providers of Community Living Supports.</p>	<b>Erin</b> will invite Stuart and/or Mary to another meeting.
<b>CHAMPS Registration Requirements - Update</b>	<p>-Discussed general registration for professional as well as atypical providers. There's been no update from State on registering atypical providers.</p> <p>-Jo of the Autism Center noted she was able to register their company, but was told because their providers don't submit direct to the State they don't have to register their atypical providers, only the licensed psychologists. Erin noted her understanding is all individuals would need to be registered.</p> <p>-Erin noted Spectrum was part of the pilot program and Monica stated they have all their providers enrolled. Monica noted it was difficult to navigate. She also found CHAMPS has no forgiveness plan for criminal convictions (after 5 or 10 years like LARA).</p>	

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	-Jo of the Autism Center asked if CHAMPS background checks will replace our own? Erin stated it is unknown at this time.	
<b>Respite Claims</b>	<p>-Discussed the difference between H0045 and S5151 Claim Codes, and Erin asked Providers to be sure to utilize the correct code.</p> <p>-Respite coding is as follows:  <b>S5151</b> (per diem) 10 hours+(capped at 10 hours)- Respite services in the client's home.</p> <p><b>H0045</b> (per diem) 10 hours+(capped at 10 hours)- Respite services out of the client's home.</p> <p><b>T1005</b> (15 min units) less than 10 hours-Respite services either in or out of home setting.</p>

Centra Wellness offers both Adult and Youth Mental Health First Aid Certification three times a year. Jo from the Autism Center asked if CWN would be willing to travel, and Cheryl responded - yes. The eight hour training can also be split up, if preferred.</p> <p>-Discussed the free trainings offered by the Michigan Developmental Disabilities Institute (MDDI) out of Wayne State university (<a href="https://www.improvingmipractices.org">https://www.improvingmipractices.org</a>).</p> <p>Monica noted Spectrum took advantage of the trainings and had them present about a month ago. She noted you need 20 or more Staff for them to</p>	

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	<p>bring the training to you. They chose <i>Stress Management</i>, and <i>Creating a Culture of Support</i>. Resource documents were made available at the trainings. So far, she has received positive feedback from Staff.</p> <p>-Erin noted she is sending out emails to all the Provider's notifying everyone of Learning Opportunities, as well as updating our website (<a href="http://www.centrawellness.org">http://www.centrawellness.org</a>) under the "For Providers", "Learning Opportunities" section.</p> <p>- Jo of the Manistee Council on Aging noted there is a training being held on February 24<sup>th</sup> at the Manistee Senior Center on <i>Dementia and Family Dynamics</i> starting at 10am for volunteers, and then open to the public at 11am.</p> <p>-Erin discussed the State's plan for Training Reciprocity.</p>
